Ullapool Village

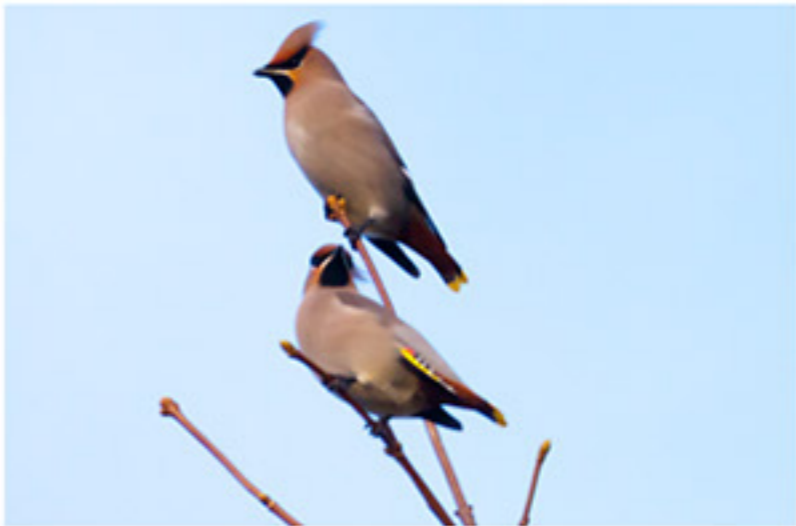
- Traditional fishing village of Ullapool adjacent to harbour

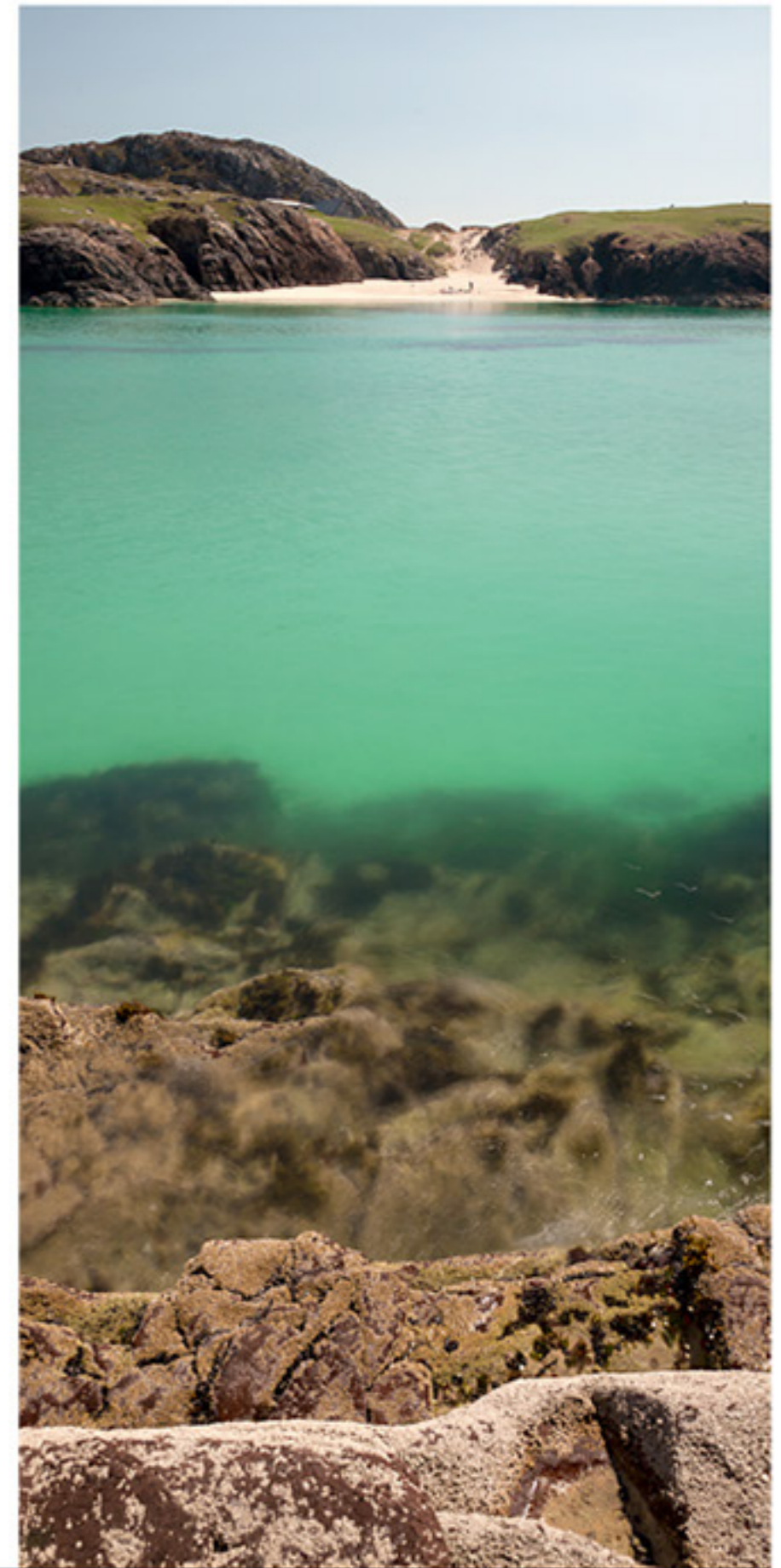

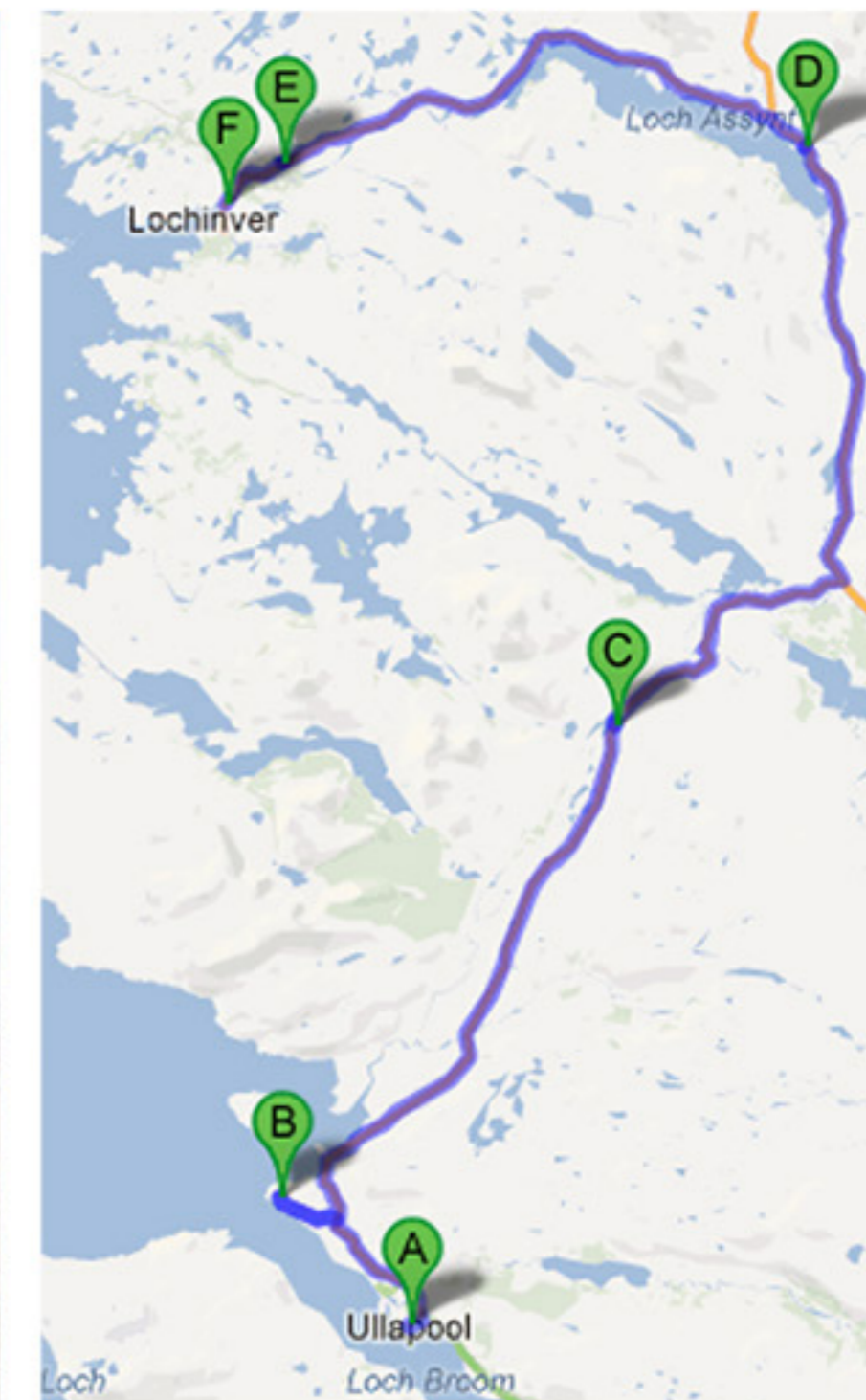


Trips to Local Islands

Road Trip North (Lochinver)

116 km return trip

- Drive through vast Unesco-endorsed Assynt landscape
- Breathtaking scenery, centre of geological and historic interest
- Awe-inspiring mountain ranges, deep lochs, pristine beaches



Knockan Crag Visitor Centre is a great starting point to learn more about:

- **Unesco-endorsed Assynt Geopark, a last great European wilderness**
- **2000m² stunning mountain ranges, pristine sandy beaches, deep lochs, ancient settlements and thriving communities**

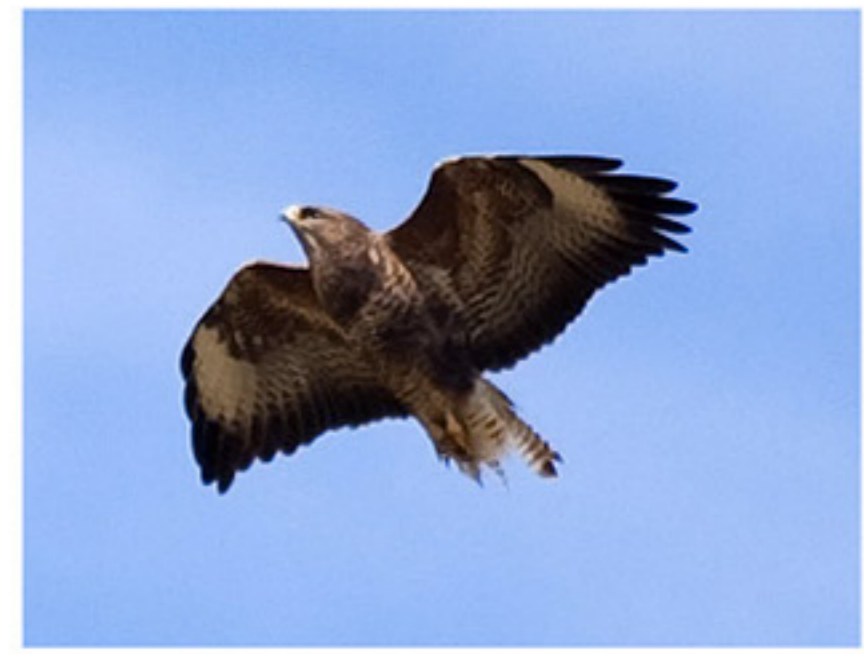
38 km return trip



Ardvreck Castle and Calda House

80 km return trip

- In medieval Assynt, visit the castle ruins and burial vault, home to the MacLeods of Assynt
- 3km away, the Bone Caves of Inchnadamph reveal 11,000 year old bones of brown and polar bears, arctic fox and lynx



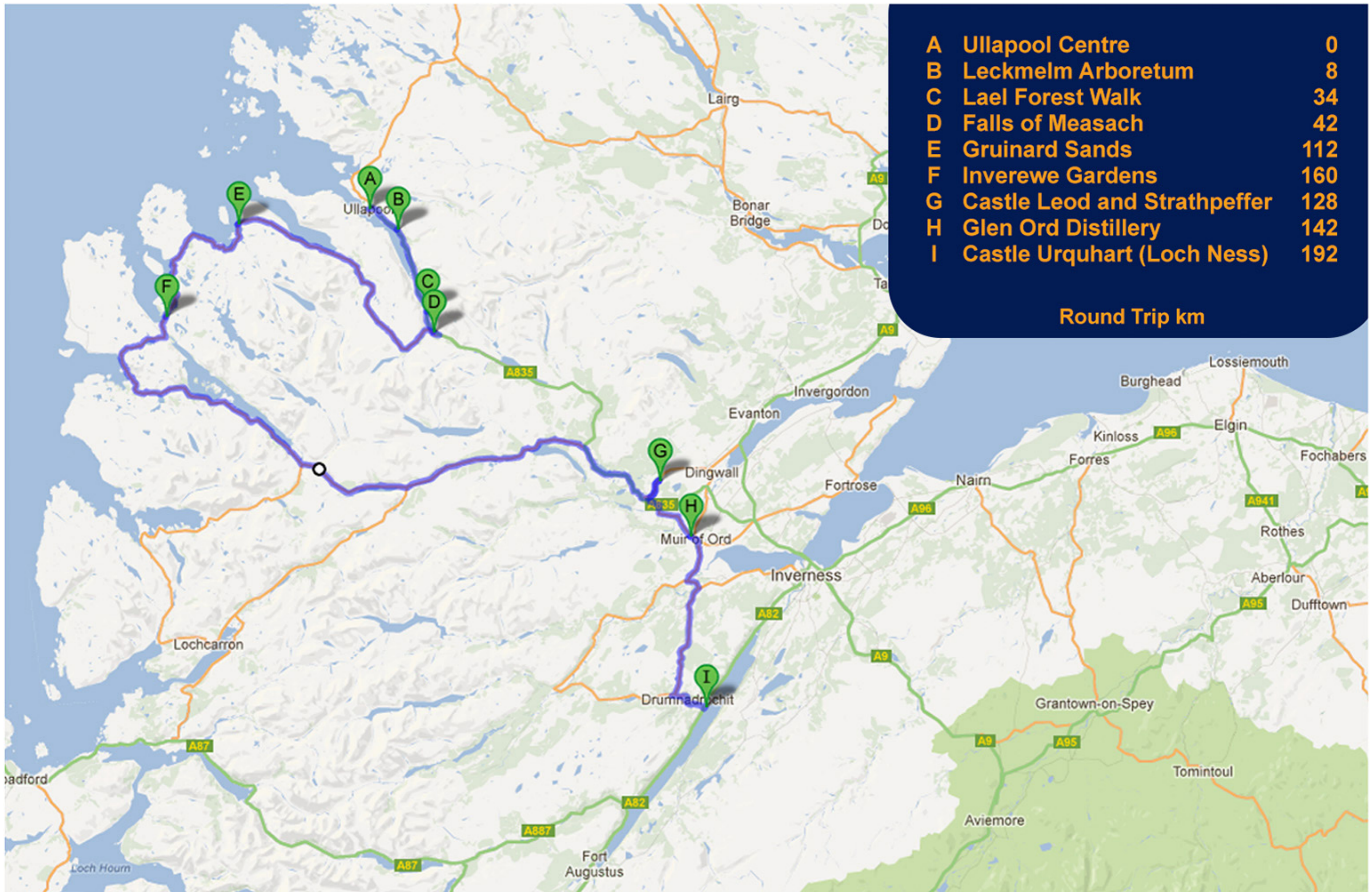
Little Assynt

- Fresh water angling from boats especially adapted for people with mobility impairments

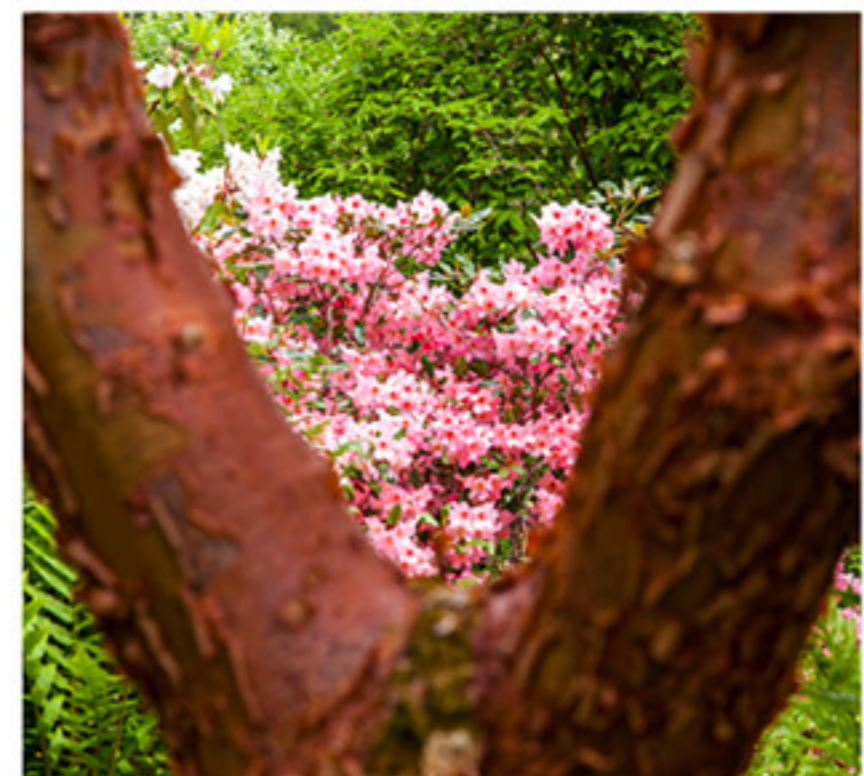

Road Trips South of Ullapool

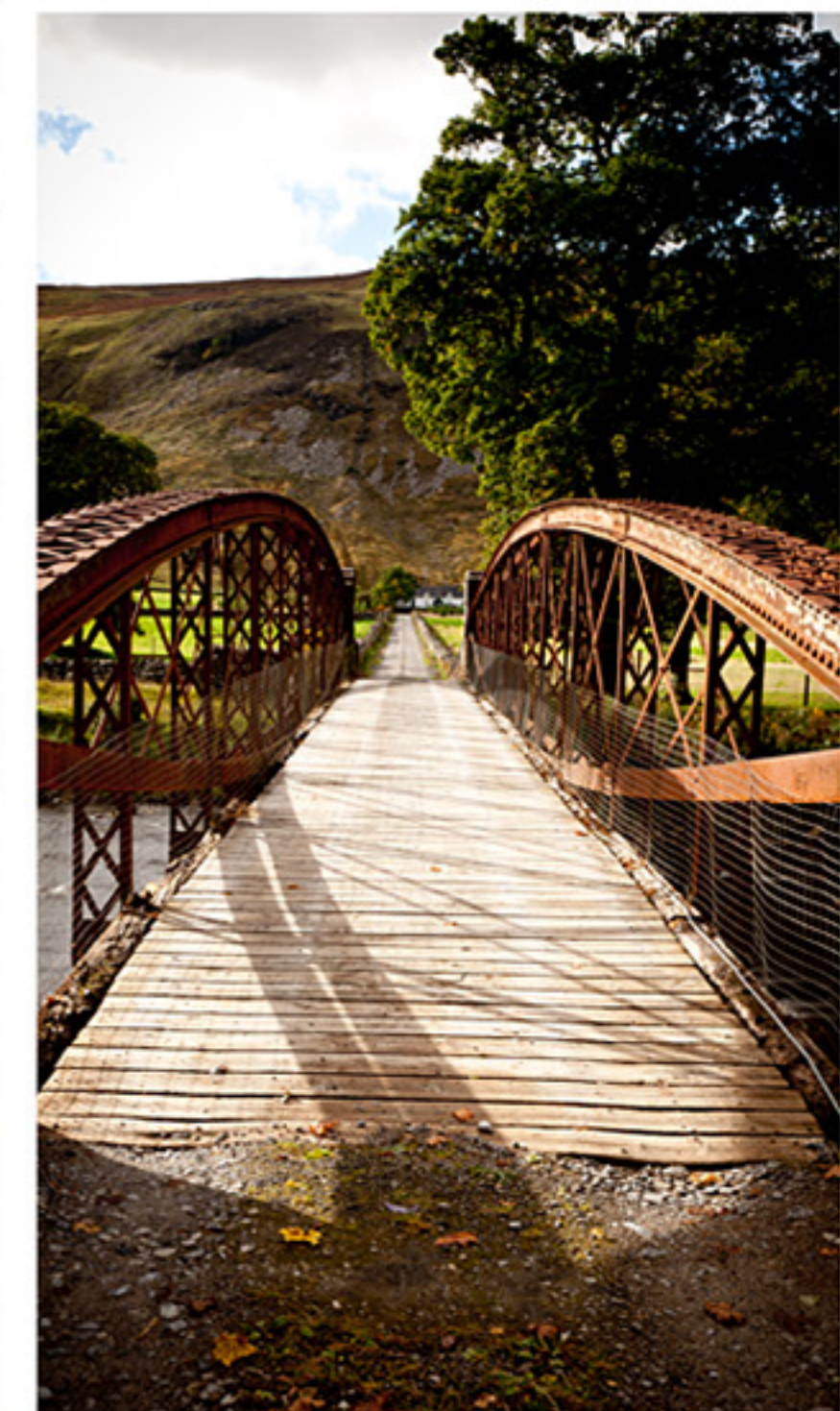
- Full and half-day trips offer a range of visitor attractions and beauty spots south of Ullapool
- Majestic scenery, deep lochs, mountainous peaks and pristine beaches dot the stunning landscape



Leckmelm Arboretum

8 km return trip

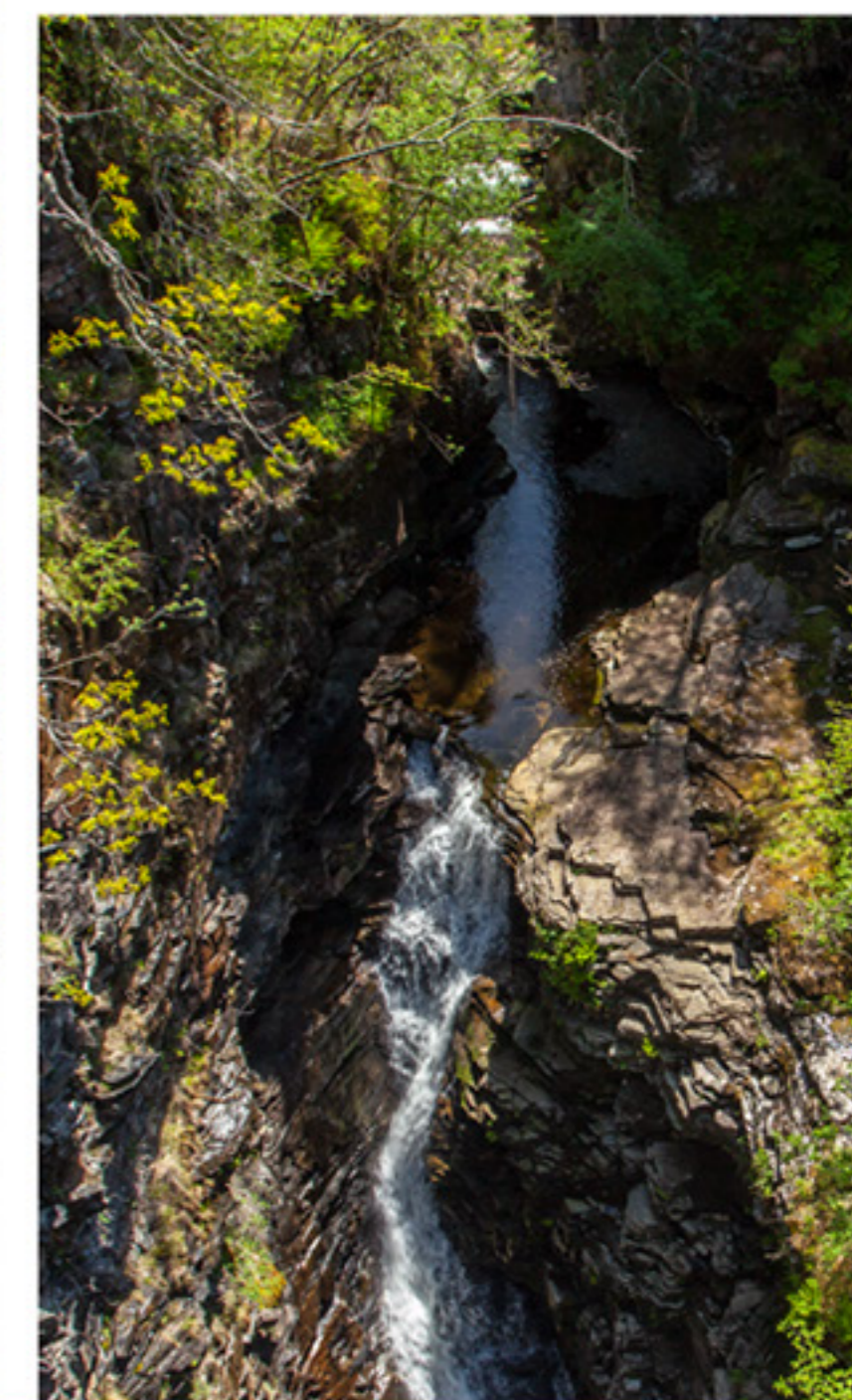
- Beautiful sheltered oasis, minutes from Ullapool village
- Planted in the 1880s, teeming with rare species of azalea, rhododendron, alpine plants and specimen trees



Lael Forest Walk

32 km return trip

- Easy, pleasant routes for walkers of even limited experience
- Over 200 clearly-identified tree species - Giant Redwoods, Cricket Bat Willows and Lawson Cypress
- Plenty of benches and resting spots along the way



Falls of Measach and Corrieshalloch

42 km return trip

- Easily accessible 60m gorge formed by glacial melt water, 100m from road
- Small suspension bridge built by Sir John Fowler with views to 45m high Falls of Measach



Gruinard Sands

120 km return trip

- **Perfect stop-off on day trip to Inverewe Gardens**
- **Pristine sandy beach - magnificent views over rocky Highland landscapes**



Inverewe Gardens

160 km return trip

- One of Scotland's most beautiful gardens
- Lush, colourful and exotic plants despite northerly latitude
- Full-day trip with stop-off points en-route including Leckmelm Arboretum, Falls of Measach and Gruinard Sands



Castle Leod

128 km return

- Home to current chief of Clan Mackenzie who gives his own guided tours
- Spanish Chestnut planted in 1550 for Mary of Guise, mother of Mary Queen of Scots
- Adjacent to picturesque Victorian spa town of Strathpeffer



Glen Ord Distillery

142 km return

- One of Scotland's oldest distilleries built 1838, west of Inverness
- Guided tours available to watch distillers at work making sweet malty dry whisky
- Opportunity to visit distillery shop



Castle Urquhart

192 km return

- Impressive castle ruins on Loch Ness shore
- Outstanding views of the world-famous loch and Great Glen
- Exhibition, audio-visual display and tearoom in nearby visitor centre
- Perfect look-out spot for monster spotting!
